On this twentieth day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand
eight hundred and eighteen, before me the undersigned, one of the Associate Judges of the
Court of Common Pleas in and for the County of Huntingdon & Commonwealth of Penna
in and for the County of Huntingdon, personally appeared Michael Smith aged thirty years resident
in Huntingdon County, in and for the County of Huntingdon, who being by me first duly sworn according to
law, doth in his own behalf make the following declaration, in order to obtain the provision
made by the late Act of Congress entitled "An Act to provide for certain persons
engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the revolutionary
war" that he the said Michael Smith enlisted in the Pennsylvania Line in the
Company commanded by Captain Albright in a Rifle Company and in the Regiment
commanded by C. Clarke & Coles in the Pennsylvania Line some time in the winter
of the year One thousand seven hundred & seventy six for one year and nine months
that he continued to serve in the said Corps for the term of his enlistment and
after that immediately enlisted again with Captain Albright for three years or
during the War and continued to serve in the said Corps and in the Regiment
afterwards commanded by Col. M. Stewart until he was discharged at Trenton
in Jersey after the Mutiny or Revolt of the Pennsylvania Line in the month of
January One thousand seven hundred & eighty One which Discharge he hath
lost in moving about from place to place; that he was at the Battles of
Long Run, Red Bank, Red Bank, Germantown, Red Bank, Brandywine
Germantown, Moxmouth, Brunswick and other skirmishes and that he is in
reduced circumstances, and stands in need of the assistance of his Country for
support and that he has no other evidence now in his power of his said service
that he hath no pension heretofore allowed him by the laws of the United
States to his knowledge and if any such exist, he doth hereby fully & entirely
relinquish the same to the United States sworn to and declared & subscribed
before me, the day and year aforesaid.
